Find out about the battle of Waterloo. You can look online, or try using your local library's *History* section to find books on the subject.

For a **BRONZE** star, your work must include:

- When did the battle take place, and where?
- The details of the 'sides' who took part in the battle.
- How long did it go on for, and who won and who lost.

For a **Silver Star**, your work should include:

- How did the battle come about?
- Why was the battle important to British and European history?
- Details of any important moments in the battle.

For a **GOLD** star, your work could include:

- Details of any other important battles during the Napoleonic wars.
- 3 ideas of what Europe might be like now if the battle had been won by the French army.

Key words that you must include in your homework:

Napoleon Duke of Wellington infantry cavalry artillery
tactics strategy Empire invasion

Key words that you could include in your homework:

victory defeat exile Trafalgar

What you will be assessed on:

1. Good use of researched information
2. Presentation of your work - would someone else pick it up to read in a library?
